The Golightly Putter was presented to the Ladies Section by Kath & George Golightly in 1987 and is therefore one of the oldest trophies that is played for. It is a Strokeplay competition usually combined with a medal and played in August. The men have a similar trophy given to them by the Golightly's that they play for.

Kath Golightly was the Ladies Section's first Captain – although she would have been the first person to admit that she was not much of a golfer. Her husband, George was a very keen golfer and probably the first employee of Woodham Golf and Country Club when it still belonged to Aycliffe and Peterlee Development Corporation. He was a great supporter of the Ladies Section and was instrumental in getting it off the ground and making sure that we had a Sunday tee time so that those ladies who worked during the week were able to take part on the main competition day.

George was responsible for running the club long before there was a club house and he worked from a portacabin in the car park. He arranged some of the first meetings with the ladies who had joined Woodham Golf Club so that they got to know each other and then with the County in order that the section was set up correctly

He became the first honorary member of the golf club in recognition of all the work he put in to get the Sections off the ground.
